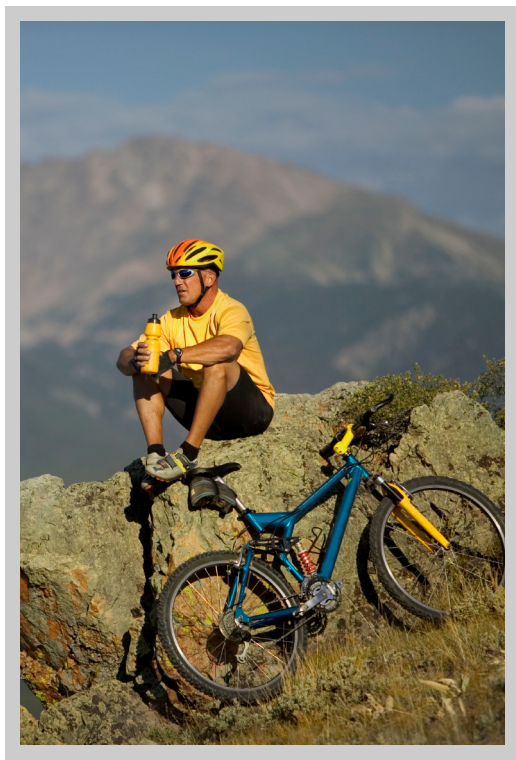




Invest Revelstoke
